APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL MEMBERSHIP

All applications and supporting documentation must be submitted online

Physicians who do not live or practice surgery within the Territory of the United States or Canada, and who do not otherwise meet criteria for regular membership, may apply for International Membership. Applicants must provide documentation that they have successfully completed the established training curriculum in pediatric surgery as required by their respective national or regional agencies.

Required Documentation:

1. Supporting letter from a local reference
2. Three additional supporting letters from APSA Regular, Associate or International members in good standing
3. Curriculum Vitae/Bibliography
4. Attendance of at least one APSA annual meeting prior to application (virtual meetings qualify as attendance)
