APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL MEMBERSHIP

All applications and supporting documentation must be submitted online

Physicians who do not live or practice surgery within the Territory of the United States or Canada, and who do not otherwise meet criteria for regular membership, may apply for International Membership.

Required Documentation

- Curriculum Vitae/Bibliography
- Letter of intent to include description of practice and how they may benefit from APSA membership
- Written confirmation of license to practice medicine in country or domicile along with evidence of successful completion of an established pediatric surgery curriculum as required by national or regional agencies. Alternatively, provide a detailed description of training and pediatric surgery case log from the prior year.
- Letter of support from a local reference
- Letter of support from a person who supervises the applicant's work

- Include your name
- Include the country where you practice pediatric surgery so we can provide the appropriate application form and assess appropriate membership fees.
